Procedure for Safe Ground Handling Practices 2. Personnel Protection • Approved hearing protection should be used when working in noise-intensity areas such as on the apron which include airside walkway, maintenance lines, etc. • Reflective garments or vest containing high visibility colours (Reflective Vest) should be worn by personnel whose duties require airside access and responsibility.

Safety Procedures and Regulations 8.1 Safety Procedures and Regulations on the Airside Airside users on the airport premises are prohibited to consume food or drinks on the Airside area. It is only allowed to drink and eat at indicated areas, example in lunch rooms. (Not on the apron, near baggage belts, vehicles, tugs, conveyor belts) .
