A DOT physical helps determine if a driver is physically, mentally, and emotionally fit to operate a CMV. If you are a commercial driver, you are a "safety-sensitive" employee.

Paratransit transportation is considered an essential service which can help people with disabilities engage in activities to support their health and safety, such as visiting a healthcare professional and obtaining food, medications, and medical supplies. DOT/Medical Information/Intrastate | DPS - Driver License

In order to drive a commercial vehicle in the U.S. with a maximum gross vehicle weight rating of over 10,000 lbs in interstate commerce, drivers are required to pass a physical examination given by a DOT-approved medical examiner to obtain and maintain a medical examiner's certificate.. Drivers receive a medical certification which is normally valid for 2 years.

DOT MEDICAL CERTIFICATION (DOT Card) Any driver who drives for commerce in a vehicle with a gross weight rating of 10,001 pounds is required to have a DOT medical card in their possession. To obtain and maintain a CDL you may be required to have a DOT medical card. The DOT physical examination is conducted by a licensed medical examiner.

One-year DOT medical certification: A top number of 140-159 and a bottom number of 90-99. Three-month temporary DOT certification: A top number of 160-179 and a bottom number of 100-109. The attending physician may recommend blood pressure medication, and the driver can be tested again for a one-year certification if blood pressure has gone down.
